

Fire Safety

ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE/ALARM



OPERATE THE NEAREST FIRE ALARM

call point if the alarm is not already sounding



NEVER FAIL TO EVACUATE



LEAVE THE BUILDING

by the nearest exit, closing doors and windows behind you if it is safe to do so



MAKE YOUR WAY TO THE NEAREST ASSEMBLY POINT

KEEP SAFE - ADHERE TO FIRE SAFETY REGULATIONS



DON'T OBSTRUCT FIRE ESCAPE ROUTES



NO SMOKING



DON'T OVERLOAD SOCKETS



NO candles or incense or other prohibited items*



DON'T wedge open fire doors especially when cooking



DON'T tamper with, misuse or remove fire equipment



NEVER cover or interfere with fire alarm sensors

Kitchen Safety



NEVER leave cooking unattended - risk of fire



KEEP HOB & OVEN CLEAN - build-up of food can cause a fire



AVOID cooking when you are tired or have been drinking



TURN pot handles on the hob away from the front of the oven



TURN OFF appliances when they are not in use and don't use them when your hands are wet



NEVER put metal in the microwave



DON'T poke cutlery in the toaster



CLEAN UP spills immediately - beware of wet slippery floors



BE CAREFUL about sharp edges; knives, scissors, potato peeler etc
